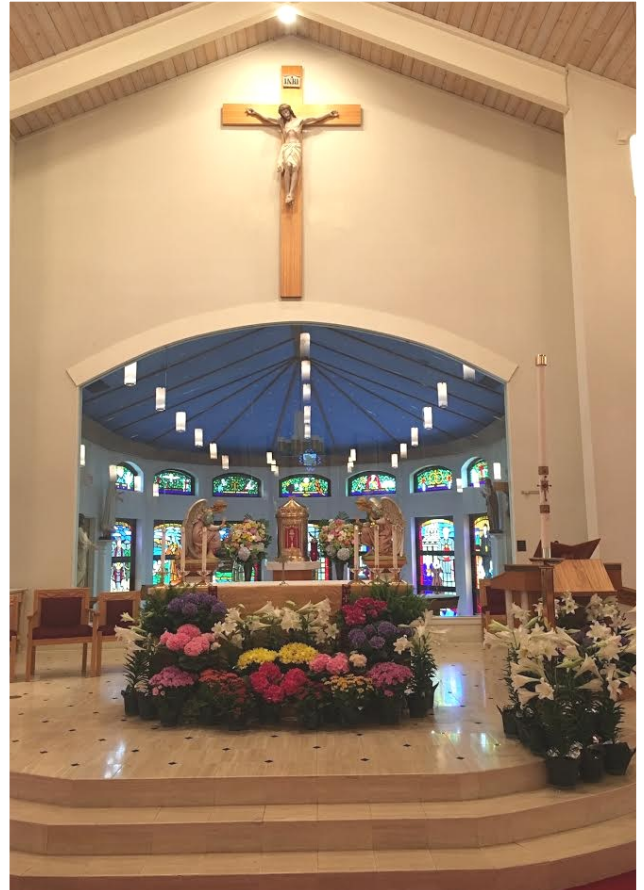

# **Phillip Smith**

*Director of Lifelong Faith Formation*

Hello Sacred Heart family. My name is Phillip Smith and I am the new Director of Lifelong Faith Formation.

I am 31 years old and a graduate of the University of Oklahoma with a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy. My wife's name is Emily and we have 5 children: Ben (7), Rachel (5), Hannah (3), Peter (2), and Chloe (1 month). We are very excited to be here in Nacogdoches.

For the last 12 years, I've been in church ministry in varying capacities in SD, TX, MD, AR, and most recently FL, mostly serving in youth ministry but also teaching in schools and directing faith formation programs. I grew up a cradle Catholic in Lawton, OK, a city about 3 times the size of Nacogdoches but with roughly the same number of Catholics. Obviously, I was in the minority, and, when I came to really embrace my faith in high school, I had many good-hearted people try to save me from my "false religion."

One instance in particular really showed me the need to equip myself to defend my Catholic faith. A friend took me aside and asked me question after question wanting justification about why I believed what I believe, and I wasn't able to give any response. I didn't know enough. So, I took it upon myself to find the answers to the questions I had. Is God real? Is Jesus really God? If so, which denomination is right?

Church history was what helped me conclude that the Catholic Church was the church that Christ founded, and, since then, I've always had an insatiable desire to learn more about God and His Church, especially as revealed in the sacred scriptures. And with this knowledge, I feel the need to share what I know and equip others for their life's journey. I don't want what happened to me, being questioned without being able to give an explanation for the hope I have (cf. 1 Peter 3:15), to happen to any other fellow Catholic.

My greatest hope is that I can, in some small way, help each of you become more intentional disciples of Jesus in the world, empowered to build up the Kingdom of God "on earth as it is in heaven."

## **Phillip Smith**

Hola familia del Sagrado Corazón. Mi nombre es Phillip Smith y soy el nuevo Director de formación continua en la Fe.

Tengo 31 años y soy graduado de la Universidad de Oklahoma como licenciado en Filosofía. Mi esposa se llama Emily y tenemos 5 hijos: Ben (7), Rachel (5), Hannah (3), Peter (2), and Chloe (un mes).

Estamos muy contentos de estar en Nacogdoches. Durante los últimos 12 años me he desempeñado en diferentes ministerios dentro de la iglesia en SD, TX, MD, AR, y más recientemente FL, principalmente me he concentrado en el área de pastoral juvenil, pero también como maestro en la escuela y director de diferentes programas de formación en la fe. Soy Católico de nacimiento y crecí en Lawton, OK, una ciudad 3 veces más grande que Nacogdoches, pero con la misma cantidad de Católicos.

Evidentemente, me encontraba en medio de la minoría, y cuando llego el momento de apropiarme de mi fe durante la preparatoria tuve a mi alrededor muchas personas de buen corazón que trataron de salvarme de mi “falsa religión.” Recuerdo una circunstancia en particular, que me mostró con claridad la necesidad de conocer mucho mejor mi fe para estar en capacidad de defenderla. Un amigo me llevo aparte y comenzó a hacerme pregunta, tras pregunta que buscaban una justificación del ¿por qué? Yo creía, en lo que creía. Sin embargo, no estuve en capacidad de ofrecerle respuesta alguna. Yo no tenía el conocimiento suficiente. Por consiguiente, tomé la decisión de encontrar las respuestas a los interrogantes que tenía. ¿Acaso es Dios real? ¿Es Jesús realmente Dios? Si ese es el caso, ¿cuál denominación tiene la razón? La historia de la Iglesia fue lo que me ayudo a concluir que la Iglesia Católica fue la Iglesia que Cristo fundó y desde aquel momento he tenido un deseo insaciable por conocer más acerca de Dios y Su Iglesia, especialmente a través de la revelación de la Sagrada Escritura.

Con este conocimiento siento la necesidad de compartir lo que sé para equipar a otros con las herramientas necesarias para su peregrinaje terrenal. No quisiera que lo que me pasó a mí, ser cuestionado y no estar en capacidad de responder a esa esperanza que tengo (cf. 1 Peter 3:15) le pase a otro hermano Católico.
